**Marina Balina** is Professor of Russian Studies at Illinois Wesleyan University. Her published research has focused on contemporary Russian life writing: autobiography, memoir, and travelogue. Her articles and reviews have appeared in critical anthologies and such journals as *Slavic Review, Slavic and East European Journal, Slavonic and East European Review, and a/b: Auto/Biography Studies.*
