Michael Schoenhals is senior lecturer with a focus on China's modern society at the Centre for Languages and Literature, Lund University. He has published extensively on the social and political history of the People's Republic of China, most recently (2006) a history of the Cultural Revolution entitled *Mao's Last Revolution* (co-authored by Roderick MacFarquhar, Harvard University) which a reviewer in the *New York Times Book Review* expects will "generate a wave of Cultural Revolution scholarship within China and encourage healthy debate over state manipulation of historical memory."

Schoenhals is a member of the "20<sup>th</sup> Century Mass Dictatorships" research network at the Research Institute of Comparative History and Culture at Hanyang University, Seoul, Korea, and consultant editor of *Totalitarian Movements and Political Religions*, London.
